Dear Ms. Borden,

At their regular meeting on Tuesday, August 19, 2011, the Somerville Historic Preservation Commission voted unanimously (7-0) to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness to

1. Remove floor to ceiling lattice from the wrap around porch.

They also voted unanimously (7-0) to issue a Certificate of Non-Applicability under Section 10 of the Historic District Ordinance, which states "Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to prevent the ordinary maintenance, repair or replacement of any exterior feature within the historic district that does not involve a change in design, material, color or the outward appearance thereof...", to

1. Repair and replace rotted and damaged porch elements in-kind as needed.

The Commission based its decision on your application, and presentation at the hearing, Staff recommendations, photographs of the house, discussion and recommendations of the Commission members, as well as the Commission's adopted Design Guidelines for Historic Districts.

This letter is your formal notification of the issuance of the requested certificate. Please note that it is valid for one year from the date of this letter and must be re-validated by the Commission if substantial work has not been completed by the end of this period. Please take this letter to the Inspectional Services Department when you apply for a
