Dear Mr. Wilkenning,

The Historic Preservation Commission received your Application for work on an historic building dated September 30, 2011 for the proposed renovations to the above mentioned building which includes the following:

1. Repair and replace worn, damaged or missing siding and sills in-kind as needed.

The Historic District Ordinance states only an “alteration to the physical appearance or architectural feature visible from a public way” is subject to review by the Historic Preservation Commission (Section 2) and further that “Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to prevent the ordinary maintenance, repair or replacement of any exterior feature within the historic district that does not involve a change in design, material, color or the outward appearance thereof...” (Section 10).

Since your proposed work falls under this section, it is not subject to the review of the Historic Preservation Commission, and this letter shall be considered to be a **Certificate of Non-Applicability** for the above work.

Please take this letter with you to the Inspectional Services Department when you apply for a building permit.
