Dear Mr. Hullah,

At their regular meeting on May 15, 2012, the Somerville Historic Preservation Commission voted unanimously (7-0) to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness (C/A) for the following exterior work on your property:

1. Remove existing circa 1940s wood shingle siding.

They also voted unanimously (7-0) to issue a Certificate of Non-Applicability under Section 10 of the Historic District Ordinance, which states "Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to prevent the ordinary maintenance, repair or replacement of any exterior feature within the historic district that does not involve a change in design, material, color or the outward appearance thereof...", to

- 2. Replace with clapboards, shingles, batten boards as appropriate per *circa* 1946 photo; and
- 3. Repair or replace wood windows and other damage trim in-kind as necessary.

The Commission based its decision on your application, Staff recommendations, photographs of the house, discussion and recommendations of the Commission members, as well as the Commission's adopted Design Guidelines for Historic Districts.

This letter is your formal notification of the issuance of the requested certificate. Please note that it is valid for one year from the date of this letter and must be re-validated by the Commission if substantial work has not been completed by the end of this period. Please take this letter to the Inspectional Services Department when you apply for a
