SECTION 1.0 INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFERORS

The City of Somerville, Massachusetts, working through its Department of Public Works, Engineering Department, is seeking quotes from responsible Vendors for the following services to be performed in Somerville, Massachusetts.

1.1 Submission of Complete Quotes

Offerors are cautioned to strictly comply with all instructions within this solicitation to ensure submission of a complete quote that addresses all performance requirements and deliverables. Failure to furnish a complete quote, at the time of submission, may result in the quote being unacceptable to the City and elimination from consideration for award. Offerors shall provide one fully loaded Firm Fixed Price (FFP) for the product and services rendered.

1.2 Response Format and Submission Instructions

Deadline for receipt of quotes is **Wednesday**, **May 8**, **2013**, **11:00 AM EST.** All quotes shall include in this order:

- A cover letter with Offeror's registered business name, address, phone number, email address, and TIN / FID number.
- Completed pricing sheet
- Completed past performance sheet (Appendix B)
 - The City requires that the Contractor demonstrate experience providing similar services for a minimum of three (3) projects similar in Scope. Three (3) references shall be provided for past performance.
- Signed terms & conditions
- Completed and signed forms

It is the responsibility of the Offeror to also monitor the bid portal on the City's website for any updates, addendums, etc. regarding that specific solicitation. 1.5 Rule for Award

The award of the contract following from this procurement will be made to the responsible and responsive Vendor who furnishes the specified service at the lowest reasonable cost, complete. This project is subject to Massachusetts prevailing wage requirements and all vendors must have successfully completed at least 10 hours of OSHA approved training in Construction Safety and Health.

1.6 Receipt of Quote

All information received by the due date with pricing and sufficient technical documentation to establish a bona fide capability to meet the requirement will be considered by the Purchasing & Engineering Departments.

SECTION 2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

2.1 General Description of Services

The contractor shall provide all management, tools, supplies, equipment and labor including all work necessary to perform repairs and maintenance of the water pump station apparatus in a manner that will ensure continuous, safe and efficient operation. All maintenance, inspection, and repair work shall be performed in accordance with (IAW) manufacturer's recommendations, standard commercial practices and in accordance with local, state, or federal applicable standards and codes or and all required safety regulations. The most stringent of these shall apply. The contract will be considered a one-time repair and maintenance project.

2.2 Detailed Description

The City of Somerville is seeking the services of a qualified firm for storm water pump station maintenance and repairs.

2.2.1 Pumps

The Contractor shall furnish and install two (2) new submersible dewatering pumps to replace the existing pumps. The existing pump is a: Goulds model WS5032d4, 230 volt, 5 hp, 1750 rpm, 16.6 amps, Serial Number: G9409234. The City requests the same or equal for replacement.

2.2.2 Control Panel

The Contractor shall replace the existing duplex pump control panel with a new duplex pump control panel. The existing panel is a Goulds Pump Control Panel, 5 hp, Max 20 amps, 230 volt 3 phase.

The pump control panel shall be Goulds or equal and shall be a duplex panel to match the existing ratings in hp, amps and voltage. The control panel shall be equipped with an alternating relay. The control panel shall be NEMA 1 rated, equipped with elapsed time meters and built for float control. The Contractor shall remove and replace the panel in the same location and utilize existing conduit and wire to make a complete connection. The Contractor shall remove existing floats and install new normally open mechanical floats in their place. The floats shall be installed for the following operations:

- Lead pump on;
- Lag pump on;
- Pumps off;
- High water alarm.

2.2.3 Lift Out Chains

The Contractor shall install stainless steel lift out chains on each pump. Each chain shall be 20' minimum length and be constructed of 304 stainless steel. The chains shall be 3/8" links.

2.2.4 Valves

The Contractor shall remove the deteriorated 6" DI gate (2 each) and check valves (2 each). The Contractor shall furnish and install new 4" DI gate and check valves (2 gate valves, 2 check valves). The Contractor shall furnish and install a new 6" to 4" DI reducer fitting for each discharge pipe. The Contractor shall remove the existing discharge DI piping and furnish and install new 4" schedule 80 PVC discharge pipe. Gate and check valves shall be as specified:

Gate Valves

Unless otherwise specified or approved, all gate valves shall be 3-inch diameter, iron body, bronze mounted, solid wedge with mechanical joint or flanged ends and shall conform to applicable section of AWWA Standard C500. Valves shall be designed for working water pressure of at least 175 psi for sizes up to 12-inch diameter and at least 150 psi for sizes 14-inch and larger in diameter. Gate valves shall be made in the U.S.A.

Check Valves

Unless otherwise specified, or approved, all check valves 3-inch or larger shall be 175 lb. W.O.G., flanged, iron body, bronzed mounted, swing type, check valves with bolted covers and equipped with springs. Check valves shall be made in the U.S.A.

2.3 Required Documentation

2.3.1 After Completion of Work

The Contractor shall submit a written report within two (2) business days. The report shall include: date and time of the service, technicians onsite, service performed and equipment installed. All reports shall be documented and provided to the Project Manager. The finished work shall be completed in a manner satisfactory to the DPW Commissioner or his authorized representative, Project Manager. Workmanship determined to be below standard will not be accepted, and will be corrected and/or replaced by Contractor at no cost to the City.

2.3.2 Waste Disposal

Work area shall then be swept of all old and excess materials, and left in a neat condition. All trash, waste and/or debris shall be disposed by the Contractor.

2.4 Government Furnished Property and Services

2.4.1 Utilities

The DPW will furnish electricity via two standard outlets in the performance of services in this contract.

2.4.2 Damage to Government Property

The Contractor shall report all damages to Government property within one (1) hour after occurrence. The Contractor shall be responsible for reimbursing the City no later than 30 calendar days of receipt of claim for all costs associated with damages to Government property in the performance of services in this contract.

2.5 Quality Assurance and Control

The DPW Engineering Department will evaluate the Contractor's performance in accordance to the project requirements. Quality assurance inspections will be conducted in a manner consistent with commercial practices. The Contractor shall provide and maintain a quality program to ensure maintenance and repair services are performed in accordance with applicable standards and manufacturer's instructions. The Contractor shall develop and implement procedures to identify and prevent defective services from reoccurring.

2.6 Period of Performance

The period of performance for this contract is July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014.

2.7 Place of Performance

All services, delivery and other required support shall be conducted at the Medford St. Pump Station within the City of Somerville, Massachusetts.

2.8 Hours of Operation

The Contractor shall coordinate all work to be accomplished IAW the contract with the Project Manager for each item listed to be repaired. The time for inspections, testing, maintenance and repairs to be performed shall be coordinated before any work is scheduled. Contractor's normal hours of operations for routine repairs shall be from 7:00AM to 7:00PM Monday through Friday, except on US holidays listed below. Please note that any changes to traffic patterns can only be made between the hours of 9:00AM – 3:00PM

2.8.1 Holidays

UNLESS otherwise specified in these provisions, services will be performed during normal work hours. When required services occur on holidays, work will be performed on either the previous or following work day, unless specified otherwise.

SECTION 3.0 TERMS & CONDITIONS

By signing this quotation, the Offeror acknowledges and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. This Request for Price Quotation (RFQ) is governed by M.G.L. c.149 and procured using 30,30m methods (M.G.L. c.149, §44A (2).
- 2. Unless otherwise stated, the quantities set forth are ESTIMATES ONLY. The City reserves the right to purchase the items specified in any amount less than the estimated amount.
- 3. The City is exempt from the following taxes: sales, excise and Federal transportation.
- 4. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids when the City determines that it is in the best interest of the City to do so.
- 5. The City will award the contract to the responsible bidder offering the needed quality of supply or service at the lowest quotation.
- 6. All supplies must be property packaged; damaged supplies will not be accepted.
- 7. Rejected supplies will be returned to the vendor at the vendor's sole risk and expense.
- 8. The vendor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws.
- 9. Where the unit price and the total price are at variance, the unit price will prevail.
- 10. The vendor agrees to take all necessary precautions to prevent injury to any persons or damage to property during the term of this Agreement and shall indemnify and save the City harmless against all damages, loss or expense, including judgments, costs, attorneys' fees and interest resulting in any way, from any negligent or willful act or omission on the part of the vendor, its agents, employees or sub-contractors or resulting directly or indirectly from the vendor's performance under this Agreement.

The City may cancel, terminate, or suspend the contract in whole or in part for any violation of this paragraph.
- 13. The vendor shall not assign, sell, subcontract or otherwise transfer any interest in this contact without the prior written consent of the City.
- 14. Notwithstanding any language to the contrary within the body of this Contract, the City may terminate this Contract, without cause at any time, effective upon the termination date stated in the notice of termination.

If the Contract is terminated under this subsection, the Vendor shall be entitled to be paid for Supplies and/or Services delivered and accepted prior to notice of termination at the prices stated in the Contract or bid documents. Any Supplies and/or Services delivered after notification of termination but prior to the effective termination date must be approved in writing in advance by the City in order to be eligible for payment. In no event shall the Vendor be entitled to be paid for any Supplies and/or Services delivered after the effective date of termination.

- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- Awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. Once a contractor has been selected by the awarding authority, the wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract for that project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site during the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project regardless of whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.
- All apprentices must be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprenticeship Training (DAT) in order to be paid at the lower apprentice rates. All apprentices must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours. If a worker is not registered with DAT, he/she must be paid the "total rate" listed on the wage schedule regardless of experience or skills.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports directly to the awarding authority and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
- Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
