## Addendum No. 1 to IFB 16-86

The City is issuing this addendum to IFB 16-86, Ash Tree Treatment, to address questions received.

Question 1 Page 13: "2.3 Minimum Quality Requirements": does a total during a calendar year of over \$100,000, from several projects, from the Friends of the Public Garden in Boston meet this requirement?

Answer 1. YES. This will suffice the Minimum Quality Requirement.

**Question 2** Page 34: Section 3, "Scope of Work" – who decides:

- A. when parking restrictions are necessary?
- B. when a police detail is necessary?
- C. when work zones need to be marked for traffic & pedestrian control?

Answer 2. A. Highway Superintendent or designee
