Questions from Prospective Bidders

1. The bid specs state a requirement for equipment to be less than (1) year old as of 2-26-14. Is this for ALL sweeping equipment or can (1) piece of equipment satisfy this requirement?

Response: Sweepers must be no older than two (2) years as of April 1, 2014 and of the dustless vacuum variety. Mechanical sweepers will be acceptable for the heaviest spring and fall clean-ups. Hourly rates for both types of sweepers are requested on the price form.

2. Is there any way you could send me a copy of the bid results from the last street sweeping bid?

Response: Please find attached for the two most recent bid cycles.

3. Who will determine heavy rain or snow cancellation of street sweeping, the DPW or the contractor?

Response: The DPW Commissioner or designee will determine any cancellation due to weather or other circumstances.

4. Is it understood that the DPW is paying for disposal?

Yes. DPW is responsible for hauling to the disposal site located in Cambridge, MA. DPW is billed for this service directly.

5. Would contractor be allowed to use DPW wash pad to clean their machine?

No, the contractor may under no circumstance use the DPW wash pad.

Specification Revision

One of the routes has been revised to include additional streets in the new Assembly Square neighborhood. The updated route is included in this addendum and replaces the corresponding route sheet in the IFB.


