### Addendum No. 1 to RFP 17-10

#### **Ouestions Received**

1) Is there an anticipated volume? Do you have an estimate of how many students/families will be in need of services.

Several dozen students at any given time, with the specific number changing as issues get resolved and new issues with new students emerge.

- 2) Is the program manager required to speak Spanish or can we use a consultant? The person delivering the wraparound coordination services should possess a high level of Spanish.
- 3) Are you looking for one dedicated clinician or can we work as a flexible team? A flexible team is permissible, however, we will look favorably at arrangements that allow students, staff, and families to develop ongoing relationships.
- 4) Does all staff need to have MSW or similar credentials. In our wraparound team, we typically have a MA level work with a BA level clinician such as a Family Partner or other Family Support Worker?

Please refer to the competitive advantage criteria outlined in the RFP. The credential thresholds we set are meant to convey the level of skill required for the position (we care more about someone's capacity to be effective and to translate significant experience into this role than their specific educational background)

- 5) Are we allowed to use a City of Somerville employee as one of the 3 references? Yes.
- 6) Are there parameters to follow in the writing of the proposal such as a minimum/maximum number of pages?

- 7) We noticed a request to "Develop and offer professional trainings, workshops, handouts, etc. as needed, estimated to be several or more a year. Are you looking for a separate cost center for these trainings or will they be rolled into a single hourly rate?
