Updates and Revisions

1. <u>Updated Price Form</u>

In response to the questions (a. and b.) below, the Form for General Bid has been revised since Addendum #2 and is attached hereto. The attached form replaces the original and revised form from Addendum #2. All bidders shall complete the attached form and submit along with the other required bid documents on the Bidder's Checklist.

Note that the unit price items are deleted. There are no unit price items in this bid.

- Fence installation for the estimated quantity of 2,000 linear feet referenced in IFB shall be carried by the bidder in the lump sum base bid.
- Asbestos abatement related <u>only to the demolition of the foundations</u> (see item #2 below) will be bid separately once the structures are demolished and once estimated quantities are determined.
- All bidders shall include the price for all asbestos abatement of the buildings to grade in their lump sum base bid.
- a. Question: In the original specs/addendum 1 we were told to carry 2,000 lf of fencing in our original base bid and then carry a unit price. Per addendum #2 Is the fence price just being listed as a unit price or are we still carrying the 2,000 linear feet in our base bid?
 - Response: Bidders shall carry 2,000 linear feet in their base bids. The unit price for fencing has been deleted.
- b. Question: Per addendum #2, we are to carry a price per square foot for the asbestos (foundation) removal / disposal. This material is disposed as by the ton. Can you please revise the disposal cost per ton instead of square footage?

Response: The unit price for asbestos abatement of foundation materials has been deleted. Asbestos remediation will be separately bid once the estimated quantities are known.

2. Backfilling

Question: I see we are now removing foundations.....So are all slab, foundation, and basements being removed? Are we responsible for backfilling in any areas?

Response: Yes.

3. Rule for Award

Section III of the IFB shall be revised: One contract will be awarded to the responsible and eligible Bidder offering the lowest base bid pricing to:

- raze the structures (including foundations) found on the site,
- remove all debris and materials in relation to the demolition and the site's prior use (lump sum to include cost of debris removal and disposal to grade); note: remediation of ACM's of the foundations to be bid separately.
- and secure and restore the property within an enclosed fence line (lump sum to include estimated quantity of 2,000 linear feet) to a smooth finish suitable for pubic uses.

The Undersigned Bidder understands that the contractor and subcontractors will be required to pay prevailing wages to laborers and that if the Undersigned's bid is significantly below the average bid, the Awarding Authority may require the Bidder to substantiate that the bid is based on payment of wages at prevailing rates.

- **M.** The Undersigned Bidder certifies that it can achieve substantial completion by:

The base bid shall be the basis of award. The above prices shall include all labor, materials, equipment, installation, testing, overhead, profit, and insurance to cover the work called for. Bidder understands that the Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality in the bidding.

The time period for holding bids shall be 60 days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of bids.

The bidding and award of the contract shall be in full compliance with Massachusetts General Laws. c.149 as last revised.

The bidder understands that the Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bidding.

The bid security accompanying this Bid shall be in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Bid payable to the City of Somerville.

The date of completion of this contract is 90 days from Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages specified in this contract are \$500 per day for each calendar day beyond the contract completion date that work remains uncompleted.

The undersigned agrees that if the Owner accepts this Bid, the bidder will duly execute and acknowledge the AGREEMENT and furnish, duly executed and acknowledged, the required CONTRACT BONDS within five (5) days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after notification that the AGREEMENT and other Contract Documents are ready for signature.

A performance bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total amount of the bid with a surety company qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will be required for faithful performance of the contract, as well as a labor and materials bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total bid amount.

Should the bidder fail to fulfill any of his agreements as herein above set forth, the Owner shall have the right to retain as liquidated damages the amount of the bid check or cash which shall become the Owner's property. If a bid bond was given, it is agreed that the amount thereof shall be paid as liquidated damages to the Owner by the Surety.

The bidder, by submittal of this Bid, agrees with the owner that the amount of the bid security deposited with this Bid fairly and reasonably represents that amount of damages that the Owner will suffer due to the failure of the bidder to fulfill his agreements as above provided.

The General Bidder shall pay and shall be responsible for ensuring that all subcontractors pay wages at State Prevailing Wage Rates; and the General Contractor shall comply and shall ensure that all subcontractors comply with the Commonwealth's wage reporting requirements. The State Prevailing Wage Rates applicable to this project are included with the bid documents.
