Questions & Answers

1. Section 1.1, pg. 2 of the .pdf: The RFP requests that 3-ring binders are not used to submit proposals, however in Section 1.3 on page 4 of the .pdf, the RFP states that all binders should "allow for easy removal and replacement of pages." 3-ring binders are typically the easiest way to allow you remove individual pages. If you do not want these type of binders, which do you prefer?

We usually end up discarding the 3-ring binders as soon as we receive the proposals as they are too large to file. The methods that we are prefer are using spiral or coil bound proposals or simply using binder clips.

2. Section 2.0, Scope of Work, pgs. 13-14 of the .pdf: Following the Quality Requirements Form, the RFP states that proposers must submit written information that details the general background, experience, and qualifications of the proposers. Should this be submitted with the form as an attachment? Or can this information be provided in the body of our technical proposal?

We would prefer that information detailing the general background, experience, and qualifications of the proposers be submitted in the body of the technical proposal.

3. Section 2.0, pg. 13 of the .pdf: Relatedly, the Quality Requirements form requests portfolio links, references, etc. Should this information be submitted with the form as an attachment? Or can it be provided in the body of our technical proposal?

Portfolio links, references etc. may be included in the body of the technical proposal.

4. Section 3.0, Proposers' Checklist, pg. 15 of the .pdf: Are there formal Acknowledgement of Addenda (non-price related) and Reference Forms we should use? They do not appear to be included with the RFP packet.

You may acknowledge all addenda on the first page of this addendum or subsequent addenda. A Reference form is attached as part of this addendum.
