The City is issuing this addendum to RFP 15-25 Design Services for Otis St. Playground to provide additional information and to clarify two errors in the RFP:

PLEASE BE SURE TO ACKNOWLEDGE THIS ADDENDUM BELOW

- 1. Error/Inconsistency in Due Date Throughout RFP:
 - o In several places throughout the RFP, there is an erroneous notation of a due date of 10/18/14 by 11am EST. THIS IS INCORRECT.
 - o **In every instance, the City is hereby** *replacing* 10/18/14 by 11am EST *with* 10/17/14 by 11am EST
- 2. Error in name of RFP:
 - o This project is for design services for Otis St. Playground, not Otis St. Park.
 - o In every instance, the City is hereby *replacing* "Park" *with* "Playground"
- 3. Questions and Answers:
 - Q. What is the anticipated construction/ Site Improvements budget?

A. The final budget has not been determined. It will be largely dependent on the final design.

Q. The RFP mentions that this project will not make any structural alterations to the bridge/ramp. Would surface alterations be allowed?

A. If additional funds are approved, the City would like to make improvements to the ground plane of the State portion of the playground.

- Q. With half of the park owned by MassDOT, will the project scope require preparations for MassDOT review and approval?

 A. Yes.
- Q. Is there an up-to-date Survey of the Site?

A. Not at this time; however, a survey will be conducted at some point in the near future.

- Q. Do you accept proposals from firms that have been in business under one year?

 A. The Minimum Quality Requirements (p. 18) for this RFP are "Five (5) or more years of experience providing similar services to other communities."
- Q. We are interested in the Otis Park RFP. I was able to download the RFP for Otis Park from the City's website, however in it, it mentions an attachment of the City assessor's map and a page of park images which I was not able to locate. Is it possible to receive the map and images by email?

A. They are attached here at as Attachment 1.


