## The purpose of this Addendum is to provide answers to questions.

Q: Under Task 2.2.3 Field Investigations, the RFP requires additional inspections and investigations in the Primary and Sewer Separation Areas on the existing sewer drain and combined systems. There is no indication of the pipes to be inspected. Without information on pipe lengths and sizes we cannot develop a level of effort and budget.

A: Copy of the existing system map has been attached to Addendum 1. Pipe lengths, materials and sizes can be seen.

Q: Under Task 2.2.3 the RFP calls for performing private building inspections and dye testing "as necessary" to confirm service lateral connectivity. We need a building count or

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# map showing the properties to be inspected in order to develop our level of effort and budget.

A: The system map shows the parcels that abut the project area. The intent of this design is that the proposed system in Nunziato field will capture stormwater only. It is impossible to know if we will need to inspect 1 or 100 homes until initial investigations on the existing drainage system are completed. If there are signs of combined flows, investigations into homes will be completed. If there are concerns about a building count, it is suggested that consultants carry inspection of 25 homes.
