V. Rule for Award

One contract will be awarded to the responsible and eligible bidder offering the lowest total price. All bids shall be measured by adding the building maintenance price; and <u>500 hours</u> of regular rate hours; and <u>250 hours</u> of emergency hours. The number of hours utilized here are estimates for purposes of measuring each vendor's bid on an equal footing.

The award shall be made to the responsible and responsive bidder with the lowest price combining the first year base price plus the first year labor rate hours.

The Vendor proposes to inspect, test and maintain the fire alarm systems and sprinkler alarm systems as indicated in these specifications for the amounts listed below, it being understood that the city will be sole judge as to acceptance of bids and award of the contract. The bid proposal shall contain the vendors' price for the first year of the contract and additional pricing for the second and third year.

VI. Bid Pricing Sheet

Please bid on the following items. Prices are to include delivery, the cost of fuel and all other charges related to the services listed below. Prices are to remain the same for the entire contract period.

If you are sub-contracting services, their costs must be included in your bid pricing. You may not add additional charges for sub-contracting services to any invoices.

- 1. Two (2) preventative maintenance visit for each of the municipal buildings fire alarm and sprinkler alarm systems.
- 2. Two (2) visit for testing operation of the fire alarm systems (not less than 50% percent of the devices each visit), for each of the municipal buildings.
- 3. Two (2) visits for testing operation of the sprinkler alarm systems (100 percent of devices each visit) for twelve buildings.
- 4. 33 buildings x 2 visits for emergency service calls.
- 5. Annual Fire Pump Test for four buildings.
