I. General Information and Bid Submission Requirements

Bid Delivery

All bids must be delivered to City of Somerville, Purchasing Department, 93 Highland Avenue, Somerville, MA 02143.

Bids must be delivered by 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday February, 24th 2015.

1 copy of the bid should be submitted. Bids must be sealed and marked as follows: "IFB 15-73 Bleacher Repair and Renovation".

All bids must include a non-collusion form, tax compliance certificate, bid pricing sheet, reference form as provided in this IFB, and 5% bid surety in the amount of <u>5% of the estimated contract amount</u>. The estimated contract amount is <u>\$30,000.00</u>. A Bid bond, Certified Check, Treasurer's Check, or Cashier's Check made payable to the City must be submitted with each bid. Said bid guarantee will become the property of the City of Somerville if the proposal is accepted and the bidder either neglects or refuses to comply with the terms of the proposal. Bid guarantee will be returned within 30 days to all unsuccessful bidders.

Bid Signature

Time for Bid Acceptance

The contract will be awarded within 60 days after the bid opening. The time for award may be extended for up to 45 additional days by mutual agreement between the City of Somerville and the apparent lowest responsive and responsible bidder (or, for a contract requiring payment, the apparent highest responsive and responsible bidder.)

Bonding Requirements

<u>A Payment Bond</u> in the amount of <u>50%</u> of the total contract price is required upon contract award.

Prevailing Wage Requirements

The Prevailing Wage Law applies to this contract. The applicable prevailing wage rates are attached in **Appendix A**.

Bidders will be required to comply with the Prevailing Wage Laws, M.G.L. c.149. Every Bidder will be required to submit a certified payroll to the City every week. The City reserves the right to conduct hearings on bids that are significantly below the average bid price submitted on a project, to make findings of fact, and determinations. Weekly payrolls are public records.

The Bidder is required to keep these records for a period of three years from the date of completion of this contract.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Articles of General conditions included herein, the City may in its sole discretion withhold payment from the General Contractor with respect to a given application for payment unless the City has in its possession payroll records that are complete, accurate, and current as of the date of said application for payment. Payment by the City on one or more occasions in the absence of the General Contractor's compliance with this section shall not constitute a waiver of the City's right to withhold payment for noncompliance on other occasions.

The General Contractor shall submit payroll information on a weekly basis in a format approved by the City (form attached) numbered in numerical sequence and signed by the Contractor (including forms; for weeks when the Contractor is not on the site, in which case there shall be a notation to the effect "no work this payroll period" and a date anticipated for resuming work). The General Contractor shall submit these forms to: Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds, Dept. of Public Works, One Franey Road, Somerville, MA.

Changes and Addenda

If any changes are made to this IFB, an addendum will be issued. Addenda will be mailed or faxed to all bidders on record as having picked up the IFB. No changes may be made to the bid documents, by the Bidders; without written authorization and/or an addendum from the Purchasing Department.

II. Purchase Description/Scope of Services

Contract Term Length and Renewal Options

The contract will remain in effect for <u>one year</u>, from on or about March 1st, 2015 to on or about February 28th, 2016.

Price Submission

The Bidder is expected to provide a total project price, as requested on the price submission page. The City is requesting pricing for the repair and renovation of Hussey-brand bleachers at the Somerville High School.

All prices must include travel time, fuel costs, delivery, and any other additional costs not provided for on the bid price sheet.

Brand Name "Or Equal"

Any references to any brand name or proprietary product in the specifications shall require the acceptance of an equal or better brand. Samples may be requested before a final decision is made. The City has the right to make the final determination as to whether an alternate brand is equal to the brand specified.

Warranty

The bidder warrants that (1) the Supplies provided are merchantable, (2) that they are fit for the purpose for which they are being purchased, (3) that they are absent any latent defects and (4) that they are in conformity with any sample which may have been presented to the City.

The bidder guarantees that upon inspection, any defective or inferior Supplies shall be replaced without additional cost to the City. The Vendor will assume any additional cost accrued by the City due to the defective or inferior Supplies.

The bidder guarantees all Products and Supplies for a period of one (1) year, or as otherwise specified herein.

Specifications/Scope of Work

Background

The City of Somerville, on behalf of Somerville High School, seeks a qualified vendor to perform the following repair and renovation services on the Hussey-brand telescopic bleachers in the Somerville High School gymnasium. The purpose of this project is to bring the bleachers and related products up to current use and safety standards. The project will consist of two primary aspects – targeted repair of the bleacher system and installation of safety end rails.

Scope of Work

<u>Targeted Repairs to Model 2400 Wall Attached Powered Bleachers</u>

- Replace all Power Track III motor; supply and install 4 Power Track IV motors
- Supply and install 12 pairs of tier catches/row locks
- Supply and install 1 male control plug
- Supply and install 4 skirt board locks and spacers 1 per section
- Replace damaged/missing frame wheels as needed
- Clean interlocking and moving frame components of the steel understructure, including:
 - o Cantilever arms, lower interlocking frame track, and tier catches
- Supply 1 new Pendant Control
- Replace and/or tighten hardware on all sections of the bleacher, as needed
- Re-stress decks and grease interlocking and moving parts as needed
- Adjust and align bleacher for proper operation
- Inspect and clean lower track obstructions

Installation of E-Z Fit Safety End Rails

The installation of safety rails on the end sections of the bleachers is required to make the equipment code compliant. The following estimated quantities are requested as part of the installation of safety rails on the end sections of the bank of bleachers:

Specifications/Quality Requirements

All replacement parts must be factory approved and certified and installed by a Hussey certified technician.

General

The work to be performed under this contract consists of furnishing labor, materials, and equipment for the specified repair and renovation of the bleacher system according to the specifications provided herein.

Examination of Property

The contractor shall fully inform himself of the existing conditions where the work is to be done.

Protection of Property

The contractor shall take all precautions to protect the property of the City from injury and shall be held responsible for all employees or any person or persons, instrument or device directly or indirectly employed by him. Any corresponding damages shall be replaced, repaired and paid for by the contractor to the satisfaction of the City.

Quality of Workmanship

Fully qualified skilled personnel must do all work in a thorough workmanlike manner. All repair and renovation work must be performed under the direction of a Hussey-brand certified technician. The Contractor shall be fully qualified to perform the repairs. The City of Somerville reserves the right to judge on the quality of workmanship of those bidding based either on prior work performed for the City of Somerville, work performed for private entities, and other public works projects. All bidders will be required to provide reference information at the time of bid.

Experience

The contractor shall have been established in the specified field for at least 5 years.

Authorization

SOMERVILLE LIVING WAGE ORDINANCE CERTIFICATION FORM CITY OF SOMERVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 2-397 et seq*.

<u>Instructions</u>: This form shall be included in all Invitations for Bids and Requests for Proposals which involve the furnishing of labor, time or effort (with no end product other than reports) by vendors contracting or subcontracting with the City of Somerville, where the contract price meets or exceeds the following dollar threshold: \$10,000. If the undersigned is selected, this form will be attached to the contract or subcontract and the certifications made herein shall be incorporated as part of such contract or subcontract. **Complete this form and sign and date where indicated below on page 2.**

<u>Purpose:</u> The purpose of this form is to ensure that such vendors pay a "Living Wage" (defined below) to all covered employees (i.e., all employees except individuals in a city, state or federally funded youth program). In the case of bids, the City will award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder paying a Living Wage. In the case of RFP's, the City will select the most advantageous proposal from a responsive and responsible offeror paying a Living Wage. In neither case, however, shall the City be under any obligation to select a bid or proposal that exceeds the funds available for the contract.

The undersigned shall post a notice, (copy enclosed), to be furnished by the contracting City Department, informing covered employees of the protections and obligations provided for in the Somerville Living Wage Ordinance, and that for assistance and information, including copies of the Ordinance, employees should contact the contracting City Department. Such notice shall be posted in each location where services are performed by covered employees, in a conspicuous place where notices to employees are customarily posted.
- 3. The undersigned shall maintain payrolls for all covered employees and basic records relating hereto and shall preserve them for a period of three years. The records shall contain the name and address of each employee, the number of hours worked, the gross wages, a copy of the social

NOTICE TO ALL EMPLOYEES REGARDING PAYMENT OF LIVING WAGE

Under the Somerville, Massachusetts' Living Wage Ordinance (Ordinance No. 1999-1), any person or entity who has entered into a contract with the City of Somerville is required to pay its employees who are involved in providing services to the City of Somerville no less than a "Living Wage".

The Living Wage as of **7/1/2014** is **\$12.05** per hour. The only employees who are not covered by the Living Wage Ordinance are individuals in a Youth Program. "Youth Program" as defined in the Ordinance, "means any city, state or federally funded program which employs youth, as defined by city, state or federal guidelines, during the summer, or as part of a school to work program, or in any other related seasonal or part-time program."

Information about Prevailing Wage Schedules for Awarding Authorities and Contractors

- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.
- All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. If an apprentice rate is not listed on the prevailing wage schedule for the trade in which an apprentice is registered with the DAS, the apprentice must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
- Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
