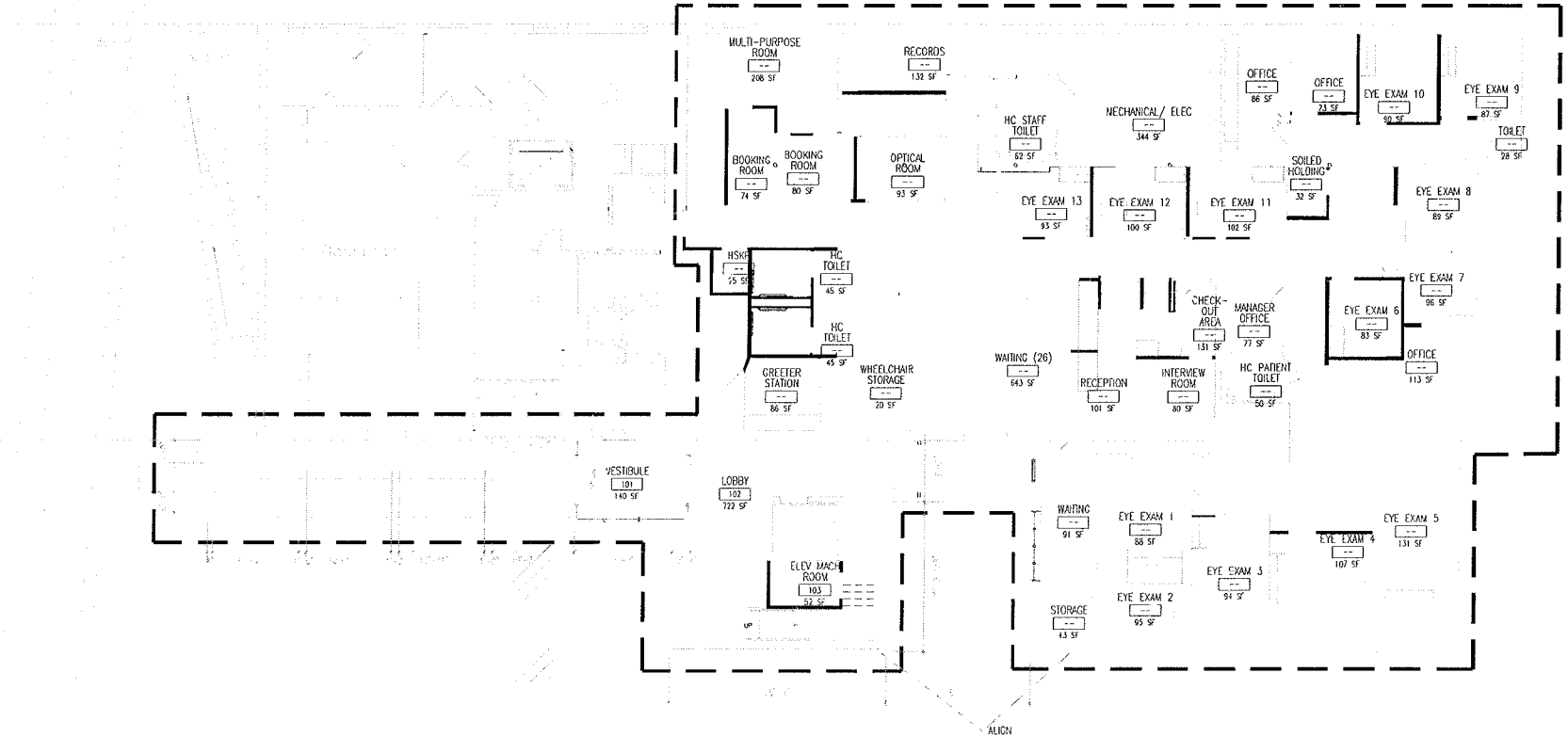

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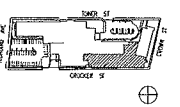

FIRST FLOOR PLAN

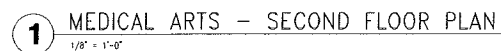

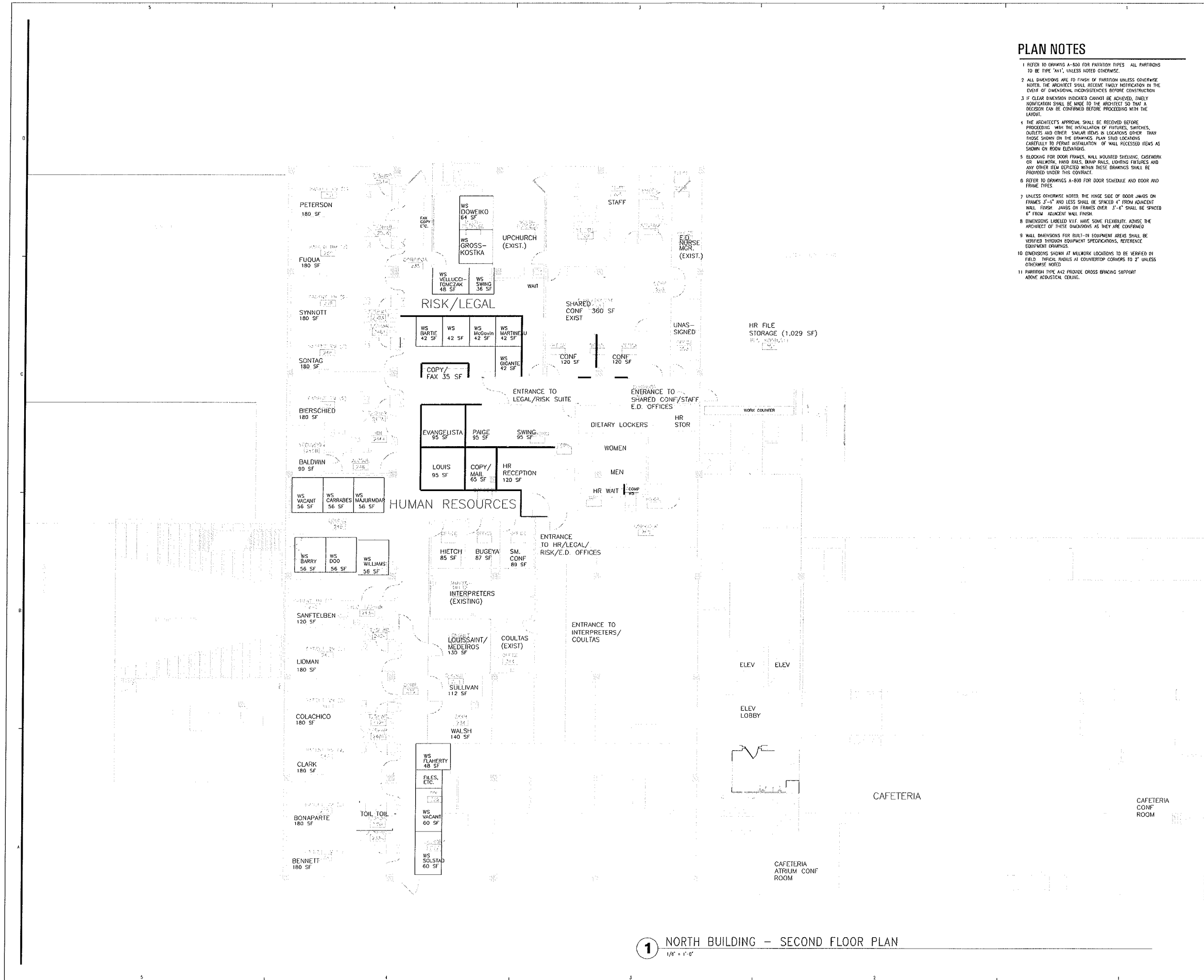

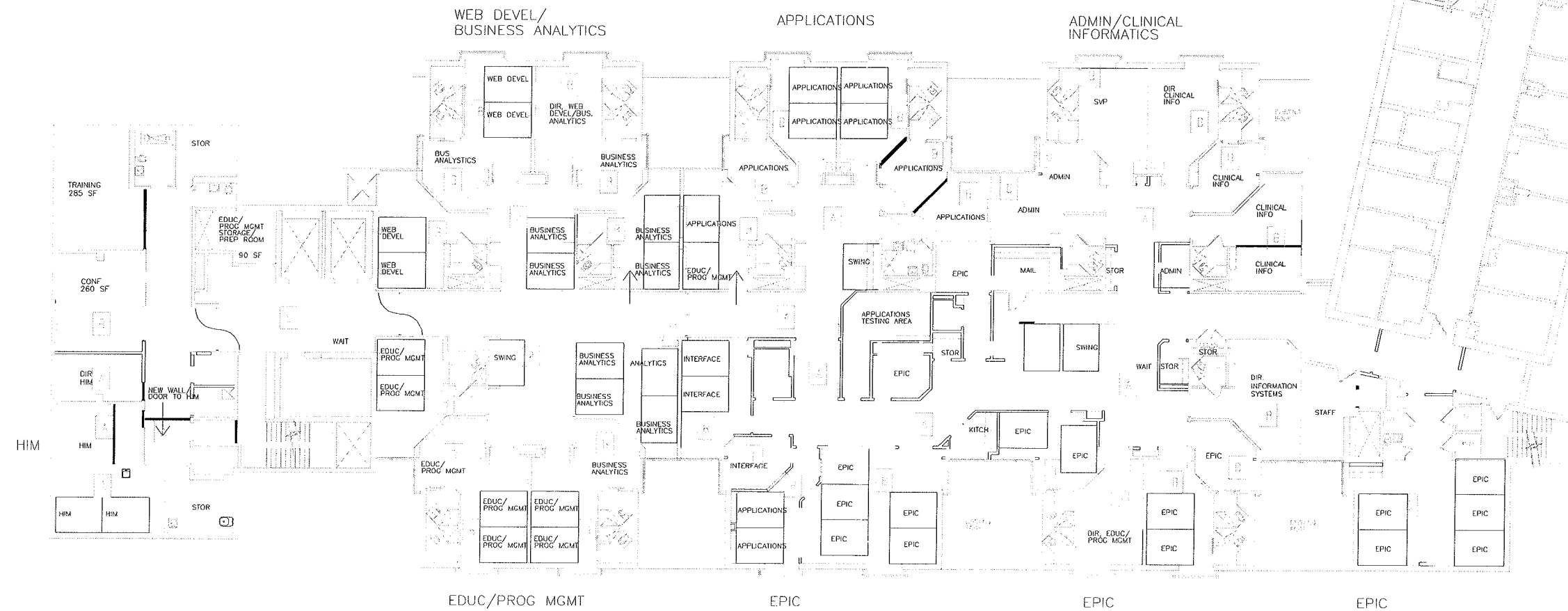

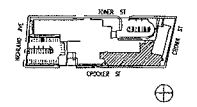

Addendum to Somerville Planning Board Application Update on Service Reconfiguration and Collaboration

Update as of 1/12/10

Overview:

Cambridge Health Alliance (CHA) announced a major services reconfiguration plan on January 28, 2009. This plan is intended to preserve important health care services for CHA's communities and patients and to secure a sustainable funding platform for the future. As a result of an intense collaboration with the State Administration and elected officials at the Congressional, State, and local levels, CHA and the Massachusetts Executive Office of Health and Human Services are working in partnership toward this end.

Together with municipal and state leaders, 3 community forums were held on February 3, 4, and 5, 2009 to get community input prior to a vote by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees unanimously approved the service reconfiguration plan on February 10, 2009. CHA also appeared before the Somerville Board of Aldermen Public Health and Public Safety Committee to provide an update on February 10, 2009. There was a Department of Public Health Hearing on April 23, 2009 to receive public comment on the inpatient adult psychiatry changes and inpatient addictions unit closure. Taking into account community input, CHA also convened a series of 3 Somerville patient-oriented community meetings and open houses in March and July 2009 to facilitate patient involvement in the transition process and to promote continuity of patient care. CHA conducted widespread and extensive community outreach through Somerville community-based organizations to reach all population segments, its Community Health Advisory Council, and the media including Somerville Cable Access TV, local news outlets and ethnic media to reach multi-lingual populations. A multi-lingual Patient Information Service was also available to assist patients and community members with 1400 phone contacts during February through June 2009.

Somerville Campus Redeployment:

CHA has implemented the overall service reconfiguration according to plans. CHA is now preparing to move forward with the exciting next phase toward the Redeployment of the Somerville Campus consistent with the overall services reconfiguration plan approved by its Board of Trustees and reviewed with state and community stakeholders. A January 25th neighborhood meeting is currently being planned for CHA and Somerville campus neighbors to review the associated construction plans.

The vision for the Somerville Campus is a vibrant ambulatory medical center and health care administrative facility. It will be anchored by the ongoing 24 hour Somerville Emergency Department and a large primary care site along with ambulatory specialty services. These include the Ambulatory Surgery Center, Eye Center, GI suite, Women's Health Center, Surgical and Medical Specialty Clinics, and a full range of diagnostic services – lab, radiology/imaging, mammography, and cardiopulmonary testing.

In order to proceed with the building modifications and construction toward the intended redeployment of the Somerville Campus, CHA will require a Somerville Planning Board "special permit" for:

- An "Addition" (addition is approximately 3564 square feet) to the existing Medical Arts Building to allow for a more visible and direct entrance from Highland Avenue to the building and
- "Change of Use" to Redeploy the Somerville Inpatient Facility from "Hospital Use to Mixed Clinical and Office Use."

This will result in the use of the former inpatient facility for CHA administrative office space (approximately 45,000 square feet of office space) and the improvement of the current Medical Arts Building for expanded primary care and consolidation of CHA's eye centers sites there. The planned improvements to the Medical Arts Building façade will provide an enhanced, direct entrance from Highland Avenue. The Medical Arts Building will feature the expanded Eye Center on the first floor (with 13 exam rooms) and the large, combined primary care practice on the second floor (with 22 exam rooms), which will feature integrated primary and mental health care in the Medical Home model.

Altogether, the redeployed Somerville campus will feature approximately 350 – 400 clinical and administrative staff, including physicians, working at the site. Upon completion of the project, the campus is expected to serve over 100,000 annual patient visits, including 22,000 emergency, 25,000 ophthalmology, 25,000 adult primary care, and 30,000 medical and surgical specialty visits and surgical procedures.

Somerville Hospital Parking Summary

Patient parking will be provided in the Medical Arts Building Lot, Crown Street Lot and the Emergency Department/Main Entrance. The anticipated volume of 100,000 patient visits per year translates into a 3.53 turnovers per day per parking space if every patient drives to the campus. Assuming 33% walk, use public transportation or get a ride the parking turnover rate would be 2.33.

Currently there are 98 employees parking that work in the Somerville Hospital Campus. We anticipate there will be a total of 284 employees needing parking when the campus is fully occupied. The 284 employees cover 3 shifts, although the bulk will be day shift employees. Employees being relocated to the Somerville Hospital campus are assigned to park in one of the offsite lots based on seniority and need to travel during the day to offsite locations.
